Notes from this Centre

The assessment centre is a cream-coloured building with a large Capita sign, located directly opposite The Goldmine Centre.

There is a ramped entrance to the right of the main door, leading into the reception area. Please let reception know when you arrive. Assessment rooms are on the ground floor, and accessible toilets are available.

There is no private parking on-site. Please see 'directions by car' for the nearest car parks.



Directions by train

The closest train station is Walsall Railway Station, approximately a 10-minute walk from the assessment centre. Exit the station onto Station Street and turn right. Follow the road and turn right onto Park Street. Continue along Park Street, which becomes Digbeth, then turn right onto Lower Hall Lane. The building is on the right. Taxis are available outside the station and take around 5 minutes to reach the centre.

Directions by bus

The assessment centre is served by several routes to the Bradford Street Bus Interchange, including 4, 4M, 11, 11A, 36, 37, 39, 45, 334, and 401E. Other services stop at Walsall Bus Station, which is about a 10-minute walk from the centre.

Directions by car

The assessment centre is just outside Walsall Town Centre. Walsall is accessible from the M6 via Junction 9 or 10, depending on your direction of travel. Taxis and drivers can drop passengers off directly outside the building, but there is no private parking on-site. There is on-street pay and display parking on the same road as the centre. Payment is made via an automated phone system using a card.

Additional parking is available at:

- Mountrath Street (WS1 3LU) – approximately a 5-minute walk
- St. Matthews Quarter (ASDA) multi-storey (WS1 1RA) – approximately a 5-minute walk
- The Saddlers Centre (WS1 1PL) – approximately a 10-minute walk

Blue Badge bays may be available opposite the centre. Please check local signage for restrictions.
