Notes from this Centre

You will enter the building through automatic doors.

The buzzer for entry is located on the right-hand side of the double doors. Our reception area is on the ground floor. Please let the receptionist know that you have arrived for your appointment.

The assessment centre is located on the ground and first floors of a three-storey red brick commercial building. The building and consultation rooms are wheelchair accessible. There is also a hearing loop.

Accessible toilets are available. There is no designated disabled parking, but taxis and drivers can drop passengers off directly outside.



Directions by train

The closest train stations are Central Station (BT1 3PS), approximately 0.6 miles (11-minute walk), and Great Victoria Station (BT12 5AH), approximately 0.4 miles (8-minute walk) from the centre.

Directions by bus

Europa Bus Centre (BT2 7BA) is approximately 0.3 miles (7-minute walk), and Laganside Bus Centre (BT1 3FG) is approximately 0.7 miles (14-minute walk) from the centre.

Directions by car

The assessment centre is located near Belfast City Hall.

Approach Linenhall Street from the direction of Bedford Street or Adelaide Street. As the top of Linenhall Street is one-way, take the first left and then the first right to loop around. The building is a red brick commercial property situated opposite an electrical shop.

On-street pay and display parking is available nearby (BT2 8BG), approximately 152 metres (500feet) from the centre.
