









Introduction

	<p>We are Capita. We carry out Personal Independence Payment (PIP) assessments for the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP).</p>
	<p>An assessment helps DWP understand the type of support you need.</p>
	<p>We encourage you to bring a companion with you to your assessment.</p> <p>They can support you and help you explain how your condition affects you.</p>
	<p>If you are having a telephone or video assessment, your companion will be added to the call.</p>
	<p>Some examples of who you could bring are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A family member or friend • Your key worker • Your social worker • Your community nurse

Here is some information to share with your companion before your assessment.

	<p>Your companion can contribute to the assessment, but they should not speak for you.</p>
	<p>At the start of the assessment, the functional specialist will ask if you agree to having your companion there.</p>
	<p>The functional specialist will record in the report that your companion was involved in the assessment.</p>
	<p>If the functional specialist asks you to do some physical movements, your companion cannot help you.</p>

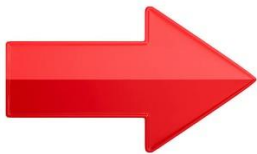


Your companion can take notes during the assessment.

The notes do not need to be shared with Capita or DWP.



If you agree, your companion can speak to the functional specialist separately after the assessment.





The functional specialist can ask your companion to leave the assessment if they are being disruptive.

This is not likely to happen.
